### **4.3. Specialized Language (Semester II)**

Depending on their chosen field of study, students will acquire specialized terminology relevant to the following domains:

- engineering sciences;
- economic and social sciences;
- biological and biomedical sciences;
- humanities and arts;
- physical education and sports sciences.

### **5. Assessment of Learning Outcomes**

Student assessment is carried out throughout the academic year and includes:

- continuous assessment (tests, assignments, projects);
- semester examinations;
- a final language proficiency examination.

### **6. Pass Requirements**

- attainment of a minimum grade of 5 in each course;
- achievement of the minimum B1 language proficiency level.

Upon completion of the programme, the following are awarded:

- Certificate of Completion of the Preparatory Year;
- Language Proficiency Certificate (as applicable).

### **7. Admission to the Preparatory Year**

Admission is carried out in accordance with national and institutional regulations.
