7.1. Admission for Non-EU Citizens

For non-EU citizens, admission is conditional upon obtaining the Letter of Acceptance for Studies, issued by the Ministry of Education and Research.

8. Hyperion Central Library

The library of Hyperion University of Bucharest is developed as an integrated system of structures that provides the documentary and informational resources necessary for the educational process. It ensures the valorisation and dissemination of information, facilitates diversified and rapid access to all categories of sources, and organizes appropriate services for its users.

The documentary heritage of the Hyperion University Library includes books, journals, serial publications, and manuscripts (collectively referred to as documents), as well as cartographic materials, printed music, audiovisual documents, graphic documents, electronic resources, archival documents, and other categories of materials, regardless of their physical support.
