

11. Programme Completion and Further Studies

Completion of the Romanian Language Preparatory Year enables direct access to:

- undergraduate studies;
- master's studies;
- doctoral studies.

The certificate obtained attests to the required language competences and eliminates the need for an additional Romanian language certificate for admission to the national higher education system.

12. Tuition Fees and Facilities

Tuition fees and payment conditions are established annually by the university management.

The tuition fee is 3,000 EUR (or 15,000 RON at the exchange rate of the day) per academic year.

Students may benefit from:

- access to university infrastructure;
- educational and administrative services;
- academic and career counselling.

13. Accommodation Offer – M3 Student Dormitory

In order to ensure optimal study conditions, Hyperion University of Bucharest provides and administers accommodation facilities for the benefit of its students (course participants).

Accommodation spaces include: bedrooms, sanitary facilities (bathrooms and toilets), corridors, internal staircases, balconies, loggias, libraries, kitchens within the dormitory, as well as other shared-use areas (storage rooms, waste disposal areas, etc.).

Students are provided with accommodation within the limits of available capacity in the M3 Student Dormitory Complex, located at 9–11 Energeticienilor Boulevard, Sector 3, Bucharest.

The monthly accommodation fee is:

- **160 EUR (800 RON) for a double room;**
- **320 EUR (1,600 RON) for a single room.**

Payment is made monthly, in advance, by the 28th day of the preceding month. Upon check-in, in addition to the monthly rent, each resident is required to pay a security deposit equivalent to one month's rent, intended to cover any potential damages caused to the property. Provided that no damages or contractual breaches occur and rent payments are made regularly, the deposit is fully refundable upon termination of the contract.
